HOW TO:

UNLOCK THE GATE



NB - PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS EXACTLY. DO NOT LEAVE THIS GATE UNLOCKED AT ANY TIME.

THIS IS WHAT YOU WILL SEE WHEN YOU ARRIVE. IT IS A NUMBER LOCK. PUT THE 5 DIGIT NUMBER CODE THAT WE GAVE YOU VIA TEXT AND PRESS THE BUTTON ON THE BOTTOM TO RELEASE IT.







WHEN YOU HAVE CLOSED THE GATE
PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU HAVE SLID THE
GATE LOCK THROUGH THE FASTENING
PICTURED BELOW.



WHEN YOU HAVE CLOSED THE GATE AND
PUT THE LOCK BACK ON, PUSH THE BAR
DOWN UNTIL YOU HEAR A CLICK AND
SPIN THE NUMBERS AND YOU ARE
DONE!
THIS IS HOW IT SHOULD LOOK NOW!



DRIVING IN

WHEN YOU HAVE GONE THROUGH THE GATES YOU WILL SEE THE TRACK GOING UP TO THE RIGHT. FOLLOW THIS TRACK ALL THE WAY THROUGH THAT FIELD AND ANOTHER FIELD, THEN YOU WILL SEE THE DIGGER.

IT MIGHT BE A LITTLE BUMPY BETWEEN GATES.

WE ASK THAT YOU STAY ON THE BANK AT ALL TIMES. EVEN IF IT IS VERY DRY.

THIS IS A WORKING FARM AND DRIVING ON THE GRASS KILLS IT AND WE NEED ALL THE GRASS WE CAN GET FOR OUR GRAZING ANIMALS.

ARRIVING AND PARKING

IF THE WEATHER HAS BEEN DRY, YOU MAY PARK PASSED THE BARN ON THE RIGHT BY THE BALES. PLEASE DON'T PARK IN THE AREA OF THE CAMP ITSELF.

IF IT HAS BEEN RAINING A LOT AND THE DRIVE IN HAS BEEN A BIT SLIPPY, PLEASE PARK ON THE ARRIVAL SIDE OF THE BARN AND WALK THROUGH THE BARN.

WELCOME TO THE CAMP!

PLEASE LEAVE THE CAMP AS YOU FOUND IT.

OUR CAMP IS A FAIRLY WILD AFFAIR. WE'D LIKE IT TO STAY THAT WAY SO PLEASE DON'T FEEL THE NEED TO WEED! ALL THE PLANTS THAT HAVE BEEN LEFT ARE THERE FOR A REASON.

KITCHEN

NB - DO NOT LEAVE ANY FOOD STUFFS OR RUBBISH LYING AROUND DURING YOUR STAY AS YOU WILL BE INUNDATED WITH WASPS. Once wasps arrive they don't go away until the end of the season so please do this for the other guests yet to arrive as well as yourselves. Thank you.

WATER

NB - THE WATER FROM THE TAPS IS NOT DRINKING WATER!

It is pumped up from the river through a filter to use for washing up, showering and the bath. The river water is very clean as the whole area is SSSI Conservation so there are no pesticides or herbicides in it.

DRINKING WATER - Drinking water is in the 2 black jerry cans next to the fridge.

FRIDGE - The fridge is a box fridge on the left hand side of the kitchen next to the bar.

THE RAYBURN - The Rayburn is the black, wood fired oven next to the sink. It is a bit of a beast to get going but once it's going you can keep it going for your stay. If you are not used to using wood burners it's probably not for you! Please ask for coal if you wish to use it.

THE BURNER - Quite self explanatory really, turn the knob and use the lighter to light it.

TOAST - There is a black cast iron circular thing that we use for toast. Put it over the the burner to warm up a bit then chuck your toast on it.

POTS AND PANS - Various pots and pans are all on the shelves.

KITCHEN CABINET - This is on the right when you walk in. In the kitchen cabinet there are all the knives, forks, glasses, plate, bowls etc.

LIGHTING IN THE KITCHEN - There are 2 solar lights above the sink, on the shelf. All our solar lights come on at dusk and go off at dawn. There is also a light switch on the charging block on it's own shelf on the top right of the back wall of the kitchen. It's the only switch working, thus far, and it's the one on the far right hand side.

PHONE CHARGER - You can charge your phones on the same block where the switch is. This is also the place to charge the black lights on the bedstead in the yurt.

THE BAR - Underneath the bar is toilet rolls if needed and cleaning products. You can use this for storage for any food stuffs you may have that you can't fit into the fridge. It is not an actual fridge though!

THE YURT

SHOES OFF PLEASE!

LIGHTING - There are 2 solar rope lights that run along both sides of the yurt. The charging bits are outside on top of the door. They come on at dusk and go off at dawn.

If you wish to turn them off there is a switch on the back of them. Leave them so they can still charge.

There are also more of the triangle solar lights that we put in the lattice of the yurt. You can dot them about where ever you need them.

They will need charging though so best to put them outside during the day!

2 black rechargeable clip lights are on the bedstead. (Charge them at the charging bank in the kitchen) They have 2 settings, click the button twice for the brightest setting.

THE TOILET

Preferably only number ones please! Use the long drop for number twos!

When you have finished doing your business, look down to the bottom left of the toilet and you will see a grey handle. Pull that towards you and that will open the whole into the bottom. Close it up again and press the blue and white button on the left of the top of the toilet to rinse.

Please put all paper and any other sanitary products in the bin provided. Thank you.

THE WOOD BURNER

The wood burner is pretty straight forward. To light it, put some firelighters on the grate inside, then put some kindling around the firelighters and build it up and over the firelighters taking care not to cover them completely.

Light the firelighters, close the door and open the bottom door to give it a boost as it will draw in the air to get it going.

Once it's going pretty well put a larger log or two on, close the door and close the bottom but open the air vent on the bottom door to keep it going.

Once it's going well you can shut that air vent almost completely and it will tick over nicely.

Add wood as and when you need it.

There are 2 black mits to use for opening and closing the door when it's hot. If you want to keep it going all night, add some coal before you go to bed.

NB - There is a CO2 Alarm on the door frame inside the yurt. If this goes off please open the doors, vacate the yurt and call us.

THE SOFA BED - Pull the sofa away from the wall and take off the blankets etc. The back section is in two parts. Get hold of one section and pull it all the way forward to release it and then push it all the way back till it's flat. Do the same with the other side.

CANDLES - We would prefer that you didn't use candles inside the yurt but if you do, please always make sure they are in the proper receptacle! Any damage done to the yurt will have to be paid for.

THE BLIND - The blind in the roof is just a normal patio umbrella so you can have it up or down. If it is hot it is definitely worth having it up to keep the yurt cooler.

THE THUNDERBOX

Our Loo with a view, is located behind the yurt further along the river bank. It is the big cast iron box that doesn't look like much! But oh the view!

Toilet roll and sawdust is in the metal bin.

Paper in the bin provided.

If you're doing a number two please put a scoopful of sawdust down the whole after.

THE SHOWER

The shower is on the right hand side next to the kitchen.



To turn on there is a small chrome metal pin on the handle itself. Turn it to the right. Adjust the temperature to how you want it but it is a bit temperamental so if the temperature is good for you as it is, leave it.

The shower hot water is also doing the hot water in the kitchen.

THE BATH

The bath take a fare amount of time to fill but it is gorgeous when the weather is good to gaze up at the stars whilst having a good soak.

You will see a yellow hose with a watering gun on the end of it. If you just want a water fight or dowse yourself down in the bath just use it as it is. If you want to fill the bath, best to take the end off. You do this like any other normal hose pipe.

Pull back the hose bit at the end by the gun and it should pop off. Fill your bath!
